

What Worship Looks Like

We are required to cap service attendance to comply with social distancing guidelines. While it is not our intent to exclude someone from worship, please know that due to social distancing, services have limited seating.

No RSVP is currently required. However, as more people begin to attend worship, this may change.

A COVID-19 waiver is required for all individuals/families. The waiver link may be found on our homepage at www.signalcrestumc.org

Social distancing is exercised during worship. Worshipers are required to remain six feet apart from anyone not in their personal household. Ushers and greeters will assist with this practice as you enter the worship space.

Please minimize physical contact. Please greet one another with a smile and a wave, an air high five, or an air hug.

Out of love for our neighbors, all worshipers are required to wear face coverings. This practice will help to protect the health of all that attend our services and is done out of love and not fear. We are asking that you bring, and wear, a face mask. (If a person forgets to bring a mask, greeters will make one available.) Those preaching and leading worship will remove face coverings when speaking while maintaining a distance of at least 12 feet from others. When not leading, they will resume wearing their masks.

Cloth face coverings/masks should not be placed on the following:

- children under the age of two
- those who have breathing difficulties
- those unable to remove the mask without assistance

Therefore, it is recommended the above persons remain home at this time.

We will minimize use of common items. No bulletins will be distributed and no coffee or food will be served. Please remember if you brought it with you, take it with you. This will help assist with clean up and sanitation.

In adhering to conference guidelines, Congregational singing is suspended until further notice.

Bus service to Alexian is suspended until further notice.

Childcare will not be available at this time. We ask that children remain with their parents during worship. Efforts will be made to make our worship services child friendly and enriching for all.

Please do not linger as you enter and exit the worship spaces. This will help with social distancing.

Pastors will remain at the front of the worship space. If you wish to speak or pray with them, please remain in your seat until you can proceed forward safely while practicing social distancing of at least six feet.

Offering plates/baskets will not be passed person to person. A stationary box will be in place at the entrance and exits for those who wish to place an offering. Online giving means continue to be available.

No restrooms will be available for the outdoor services.
